Summary:

On August 2, 2017, at approximately 8:23 PM, San Mateo County Sheriff's (SMSO) Deputies responded to the above address on the report of a possible residential burglary. The homeowner reported hearing glass break in her residence. The homeowner investigated the noise and discovered someone had broken a glass slider in one of the bedrooms. Upon the deputy's arrival and after further examination of the scene, it was determined that an unknown suspect(s) broke the sliding glass door and entered the residence. It is believed the suspect(s) fled once they realized someone was home. There is no suspect information at this time and this case is still under investigation.

The Sheriff's Office would like to remind you to secure and lock any door or gates that lead to the rear of your home and report any suspicious activity.
