At approximately 4PM last Tuesday, San Mateo County Public Safety Communications received a call of a possible suicide at the above address. The caller reported that he had arrived home to find his wife had shot herself. The victim was located in a bedroom within the residence and pronounced dead by EMS personnel from Woodside Fire Protection District.

Evidence located at the scene and findings from the autopsy later revealed that the injury suffered by the victim was not self inflicted. The case is currently under investigation as a homicide.

The victim has been identified as 56 year old Parima Parineh who lived at the residence with her husband, Pooroushasb (Peter) Parineh, and two adult children. The residence is located in an affluent area of unincorporated San Mateo County off of Highway 84 near Woodside.

The Sheriff's Office has not identified a particular suspect and is investigating several potential leads. There were no signs of forced entry to the residence nor is there any evidence that the suspect is a stranger. Efforts are being made to thoroughly interview all the family members however they are not cooperating with the investigation.
