On December 27, 2011, at approximately 1930 hours, a woman reported that she was walking along the pedestrian trail between Kelly Avenue and Filbert Street in Half Moon Bay. She was walking with her two year old child in a stroller after visiting friends. The victim had placed her cell phone in her jacket pocket after receiving a text and was carrying a purse on her shoulder as she returned home. As she approached Filbert Street, she heard footsteps behind her and was suddenly pushed from behind by an unknown suspect. The victim and suspect both fell to the ground and the suspect began pulling on the victim's jacket. When the victim's child began to cry, the suspect then fled northbound along the trail. The victim sustained a bruise to her knee. The child was unharmed and remained upright in the stroller. The victim returned home and then went to the Half Moon Bay Substation to report the incident.

The victim was unable to provide any information or physical description of the suspect. Additional follow-up investigation is being conducted in attempt to develop further information in this case.
