Incident Date and Time: Sunday, September 17, 2017 at approximately 9:00pm

Location: 2500 Middlefield Road, Redwood City

Type of Crimes/Incident: False Imprisonment

Suspect Information: Unknown black male adult

Summary:

Redwood City, CA- On Saturday, 09/17/2017, at approximately 9:00pm, an unknown black male adult walked up to a 15 year old female as she was walking near the 2500 block of Middlefield Road. The suspect told the victim that something bad was going to happen to her, grabbed her hand and kept her from walking away.

In fear for her safety, the victim pulled away and ran. The suspect also fled from the scene on foot in an unknown direction. The unknown suspect was described by the victim as a black male adult, 5 feet 10 inches tall, 160 to 180 pounds, wearing all black clothing.

This incident is still under investigation. The Sheriff's Office would like to remind you to always be aware of your surroundings and report any suspicious persons.
