Incident Date and Time: Saturday, October 15, 2016 at approximately 7:10 pm
Location: Intersection of Rollins Rd and Adrian Rd, Millbrae, CA
Type of Crimes/Incident: Felony hit and run.

Witness #1: Possibly full size white Chevy Pick-up truck with camper shell and business markings on the tailgate and rear of the camper shell.
Witness #2: Possibly Toyota or similar white mid-size king cab pick-up truck with black bed liner.

Summary:

The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Millbrae Bureau is asking for the public's help in identifying vehicles and witnesses in a fatal hit and run accident.

On Saturday, October 15, 2016, at approximately 7:10 pm, Sheriff's Deputies responded to the intersection of Rollins Road and Adrian Road on the report of an auto versus pedestrian accident. Upon their arrival, an off duty paramedic was administering first aid to a victim laying in the crosswalk in front of the center median on Rollins Road.

No vehicles were found at the scene. Investigation so far has indicated five vehicles in the area as being possible witnesses.

The victim, a female in her 70's, was transported to San Francisco General Hospital, but succumbed to her injuries. This investigation is still on going.
