Incident Date and Time: Thursday, February 22, 2018, at approximately 8:50 pm

Location: Residential building in the 1-100 block of South Broadway, Millbrae

Type of Crime/Incident: Residential Burglary, Mail Theft

Suspect: Jose Sajuan, 22 years old, Redwood City resident

Summary:

Millbrae, CA – On Thursday, February 22nd, 2018, at approximately 8:50pm, Sheriff's Office Deputies responded to a report of a subject illegally opening numerous packages inside an apartment complex.

During a search of the complex, the suspect Jose Sajuan, was caught while in possession of stolen property. Jose Sajuan admitted to gaining access to the secured building by following behind a resident. Jose Sajuan was booked into the San Mateo County Jail for burglary and mail theft.

The Sheriff's Office reminds people to be aware of their surroundings, not to let unfamiliar people into secured areas, and to report any suspicious people or activities.
