Incident Date and Time: Wednesday, March 21st, 2018 at approximately 4 AM
Location: On the 100 block of Hermosa Road, Montara
Type of Crimes/Incident: 664/187PC- Attempted homicide, 203{C – Mayhem, 245PC- Assault with a deadly weapon
Suspect Information: **Phillip Turner, 28-year-old El Granada resident**

Summary:

On Wednesday, March 21st, 2018 at approximately 4 AM, Deputies responded to the 100 block of Hermosa Road, in Montara on a report of a stabbing. When they arrived on scene they located the male adult victim in critical condition. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he remains in critical condition. The suspect was positively identified and he was placed under arrest. This was an isolated incident and there is no reason to believe the public is at risk.
