Suspect Information: Juan Francisco Garcia, 46 year old Redwood City resident.

Summary:

On Saturday, May 12th, 2018, at approximately 1840 hours, deputies responded to a report of a family disturbance at a residence on the 500 block of Hurlingame Avenue. Upon arrival, deputies contacted a male subject who was in possession of a stolen handgun. The subject was detained and identified as Juan Garcia.

Upon investigation, it was learned that Juan Garcia had an argument with his mother and threatened to kill himself. Garcia fired rounds through a bedroom door where Garcia's mother had barricaded herself for safety. When Garcia's sister arrived, Garcia pointed the handgun at her, and threatened to kill her as well. Two minor children were also in the residence when the incident occurred. Garcia eventually put down his gun and no one was physically harmed.

Juan Garcia was subsequently placed under arrest and booked into the San Mateo County Jail for the above listed charges.
