Location: 1900 block of Cooley Avenue, East Palo Alto, CA

Type of Crime/Incident: 11377 HS - Possession of Methamphetamine (misdemeanor)
12022.7(a) PC - Inflicting Great Bodily Injury (felony)
11352 HS - Narcotics Sales (Fentanyl) (felony)

Suspect: Jon Oxenford, 25-year-old, male from East Palo Alto

Summary:

On September 26th, 2018, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies and San Mateo County Coroner's Office investigated an overdose death in the City of San Carlos. The Coroner's Office confirmed the victim's death was associated with a Fentanyl overdose. Through the investigation, the San Mateo County Crime Suppression Unit (CSU) Detectives identified suspect Jon Oxenford as the person who provided the victim with the narcotics (Fentanyl) that caused her overdose.

On January 9th, 2019, CSU Detectives arrested Jon Oxenford at his residence where more narcotics and narcotic paraphernalia was located. Suspect Jon Oxenford was booked into San Mateo County Jail on \$122,500 bail for possession of methamphetamine, inflicting great bodily injury, and narcotics sales.
