Incident Date and Time: Wednesday, October 3rd, 2018, at approx. 7:30 a.m.

Location: Ringwood Avenue at Coleman Avenue,
Unincorporated Menlo Park, California

Type of Crime/Incident: Suspicious Circumstance

Suspect: Light-skinned Hispanic male adult, blonde hair, clean shaven,
wearing a red sweater and black vest

Summary:

On Wednesday, October 3rd, 2018, at approximately 7:30 am, near the intersection of Ringwood Avenue and Colman Avenue in unincorporated Menlo Park, a Hispanic male adult driving a newer model dark gray or black BMW, approached a 14-year old female who was walking to school. The suspect told the female he was low on gas and offered to give her a ride if she gave him some money. The female declined, and the suspect drove away. The suspect's vehicle was described as having a paper dealership advertisement instead of a rear license plate. The female was not harmed during this incident.
