### Summary:

Around midnight on November 19th, the San Mateo County Dispatch Center received a 911 call from a female who lives on the 900 block of East San Carlos Avenue in San Carlos. The dispatchers could hear a disturbance in the background, and deputies were immediately sent to the address to check on the residents.

San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies arrived at the residence within two minutes. Once inside, deputies found the female victim had been stabbed and battered by her estranged husband who was still on scene. He was immediately placed under arrest and through the investigation, deputies found out that the suspect broke into the apartment purposefully to attack the victim. Deputies also discovered there were two children in the residence when the assault took place.
