Summary:

San Mateo County Sheriff's deputies from the Millbrae Police Bureau were dispatched to an apartment complex on the 0-100 block of S. Broadway, in Millbrae. The male victim reported that as he walked towards his car, which was parked in a gated parking lot and locked, he found the unknown female suspect (Jessica Marie Kinslow) in the back seat. She was rummaging through his belongings and when the victim told Jessica to get out of his car, she ran away into the apartment complex.

The victim immediately called 911 and Sheriff's deputies arrived shortly after. Due to the quick reporting of the victim, the deputies were able to find Jessica as she was attempting to hide near a stairwell. Jessica was identified as the suspect on scene and placed under arrest. Jessica was in possession of burglary tools, had suspected Oxycodone in her purse, and had two outstanding warrants. Jessica was booked into the San Mateo County Jail, for the above listed charges.
