Incident Date and Time: Monday, December 17th, at 8:56 pm
Location: Union 76 gas station, 5 El Camino Real, Millbrae, California
Charges: PC 212.5(c)- Robbery
Suspect: White male adult, approximately 30-40 years old wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black pants and a black mask.
Weapon used was a knife (4" blade) with a brown handle

Summary:

On Monday, December 17th, 2018 at 9:02 pm, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office deputies from the Millbrae Police Bureau were flagged down regarding a robbery that occurred a few minutes prior at the Union 76 gas station in Millbrae.

During the investigation, deputies learned a white male adult, wearing all black clothing and a black mask covering his face, entered the Union 76 gas station at 8:56 pm. The suspect approached the cashier armed with a knife, and told the clerk to open the cash register and do not call law enforcement. In fear, the cashier opened the register and the suspect removed cash. The suspect was inside the store for approximately 4 minutes and ran westbound on Millbrae Avenue after the robbery was committed.

An extensive search of the area was done, however the suspect fled the scene prior to the deputies' arrival.
