Incident Date and Time: Thursday, January 3rd, 2019 at 6:50 pm.

Location: Taqueria El Tulense 2391 Spring Street, NFO, California

Type of Crime/Incident: PC 212.5 Robbery with a knife

Suspect: Hispanic male adult, approximately 20-35 years old wearing all black clothing with a red bandanna covering his face. Weapon used was a knife.

Summary:

On Thursday, January 3rd, 2019 at 6:50pm, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a robbery that occurred at Taqueria El Tulense in North Fair Oaks.

During the investigation, deputies learned a Hispanic male adult, wearing all black clothing and a red bandanna covering his face, entered the business at 6:50pm. The suspect approached an employee armed with a knife, and told the employee to open the cash register. In fear, the employee opened the register and the suspect removed the cash. The suspect was inside the business for less than a minute and fled southbound on Spring Street after the robbery was committed.

An extensive search of the area was done, however the suspect fled the scene prior to the deputies' arrival.
