## NEWS RELEASE

**Incident Date and Time:** Friday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at approximately 11:05 AM  
**Location:** Green Hills Elementary School, 401 Ludeman Ln, Millbrae, Ca  
**Type of Crime/Incident:** PC 647.6(a) – Annoying Children (Misdemeanor)  
**Suspects:** Unknown white male adult, approximately 30 years old, brown curly long hair with a beard, wearing a blue tank top, black pants and yellow or tan boots. Suspect also had a tattoo of a snake around his right shoulder area.

### Summary:

Deputies of the Millbrae Police Bureau of the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office were notified of a suspicious circumstance at Green Hills Elementary School. The incident occurred at approximately 11:05 AM, however, the notifications to law enforcement were not made until a few hours later.

A student under the age of 10 years old, reported the unknown suspect, described above, was inside the boy's bathroom at the school. As the student was exiting the bathroom, the suspect attempted to grab him by his shoulder and hair. The student ran away, and then saw the suspect flee the area in an unknown direction. The student did not immediately report this incident to school staff.

San Mateo County Sheriff's Office would like to remind everyone with children to talk about safety plans and the importance of reporting all suspicious behavior and suspicious people.
