Incident Date and Time: Tuesday, January 15th, 2019 at approximately 3:10 PM

Location: Poplar Beach Half Moon Bay, CA.

Type of Crime/Incident: PC 664/187 (a) – attempted murder (Felony)

Suspects: Chisato Chiyoda, 36-year-old, female Cupertino resident

Summary:

San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies assigned to the Coastside Patrol Bureau, received information about a possible suicidal person at Poplar Beach in Half Moon Bay. Deputies arrived and located Chiyoda who was holding an infant (confidential victim) and they were both soaking wet. Chiyoda was reportedly seen acting strange as she entered the ocean holding this infant.

Chiyoda and the infant were treated for hyperthermia and taken to a local hospital for further evaluation. Detectives spoke with Chiyoda further about the incident, and when she was released from the hospital, Chiyoda was arrested for attempted murder. The infant was treated at a local hospital and released to Child Protective Services.
