## NEWS RELEASE

**Incident Date and Time:** March 29, 2019 at approximately 9 PM

**Location:** Quik Stop Market, 3401 Middlefield Road Redwood City, CA.

**Type of Crime/Incident:** PC 245(a)(4) - Assault with Great Bodily Injury (felony)  
PC 243 (d) – Aggravated battery (felony)

**Suspect:** Jose Adolfo Castromartinez, 23-year-old male, San Jose resident.

### Summary:

At approximately 9 PM, the victim was getting gas at the Quick Stop in unincorporated Redwood City when he was involved in an argument over a gas pump with the suspect, Jose Castromartinez. The incident escalated when Castromartinez attacked the victim by repeatedly punching him and knocking the victim to the ground. The victim was treated at a local hospital where a nurse reported the incident. The victim suffered serious, but non-life-threatening injuries and was released from the hospital.

A witness and video surveillance footage captured Castromartinez's vehicle license plate and a records check revealed Castromartinez was arrested by the California Highway Patrol in San Jose at 11:40 PM for driving under the influence.

Upon speaking with the arresting CHP Officer, he confirmed the suspect he arrested, Jose Adolfo Castromartinez, matched the clothing description and noted he had multiple fresh scratches on his face and neck area. Castromartinez was transported from Santa Clara County Jail to the San Mateo County jail where he was booked for the above listed charges.
