Location: (Borrow Lenses) 1664 Industrial Road, San Carlos, California

Type of Crime/Incident: 460(b) PC – Commercial Burglary (Felony)

Suspect: S1 - Unknown race/age male, slight of build, wearing a black hoody, black sweatpants and a white medical mask covering his face

S2 – Unknown race/age male, slight of build, wearing a black hoody, burgundy sweatpants and a white medical mask covering his face

Summary:

On March 31, 2019, at approximately 5:41 am, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies from the San Carlos Police Bureau responded to Borrow Lenses in San Carlos, on the report of a commercial burglary that just occurred.

The business owner received an alert from the store's interior surveillance cameras that showed two unknown suspects entered the closed business by kicking in the front glass door. Once inside, the suspects were seen attempting to kick open a locked interior door; however, they failed to gain access. The suspects stole two laptops from the front lobby before leaving the store. Other than the laptops, no additional items were stolen.
