Summary:

On Thursday, April 4th, 2019, at approximately 8:05 pm, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies from the Millbrae Police Bureau responded to the 600 block of Cypress Avenue in the City of Millbrae on the report of a residential burglary that had just occurred. The three suspects had fled prior to deputies' arrival.

Three suspects were seen by an outside surveillance camera breaking into the unoccupied home by smashing the rear dining room window, causing the home's audible alarm to sound. The suspects then fled, with one of the suspects carrying what appears to be a large box. It is unknown at this time what exactly was stolen.

It was extremely helpful in this case to have surveillance cameras and an alarm to help report the crime immediately and prevent further loss. We recommend people get and use security features like these as well as reporting any suspicious behavior or people immediately to law enforcement.
