Incident Date and Time: Monday, April 15, 2019, 6:45 pm

Location: 300 block of 4th Avenue, Unincorporated Redwood City, CA

Type of Crime/Incident: PC 245 (a) (1) X2 – Assault with Deadly Weapon (felony)
PC 273a (a) – Cruelty to Child (felony)

Suspect: Marco Antonio Ayapanjocop, 40- year-old male, San Mateo resident

Summary:

On Monday, April 15th, at approximately 6:45 PM, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 300 block of 4th Avenue in Unincorporated Redwood City on the report of a disturbance and blood located in the lobby of the apartment complex. Deputies learned the two victims were approached by Marco Antonio Ayapanjocop who was armed with a machete. Ayapanjocop raised the machete and threaten the victims as he swung the machete multiple times in their direction. Neither victim was struck with the machete when he was swinging it, but the male victim sustained a minor non-life-threatening injury to his arm when he reached for the machete to disarm the suspect. A seven-year-old child was with the victims during the assault. The suspect fled the scene but was later located and arrested for the above listed charges.
