Incident Date and Time: 1987 to 2015

Location: Ladera Recreation Center and a private residence in unincorporated Menlo Park.

Type of Crime/Incident: 2 Counts of PC 288(a) – lewd and lascivious acts with a child under 14

Suspect: **Randolph Haldeman, 47-year-old, unincorporated Menlo Park resident.**

Summary:

In January 2019, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office deputies received information about multiple sexual assaults that occurred over several years at the Ladera Recreation Center. The information was handed over to San Mateo County Sheriff Office detectives who conducted a thorough investigation.

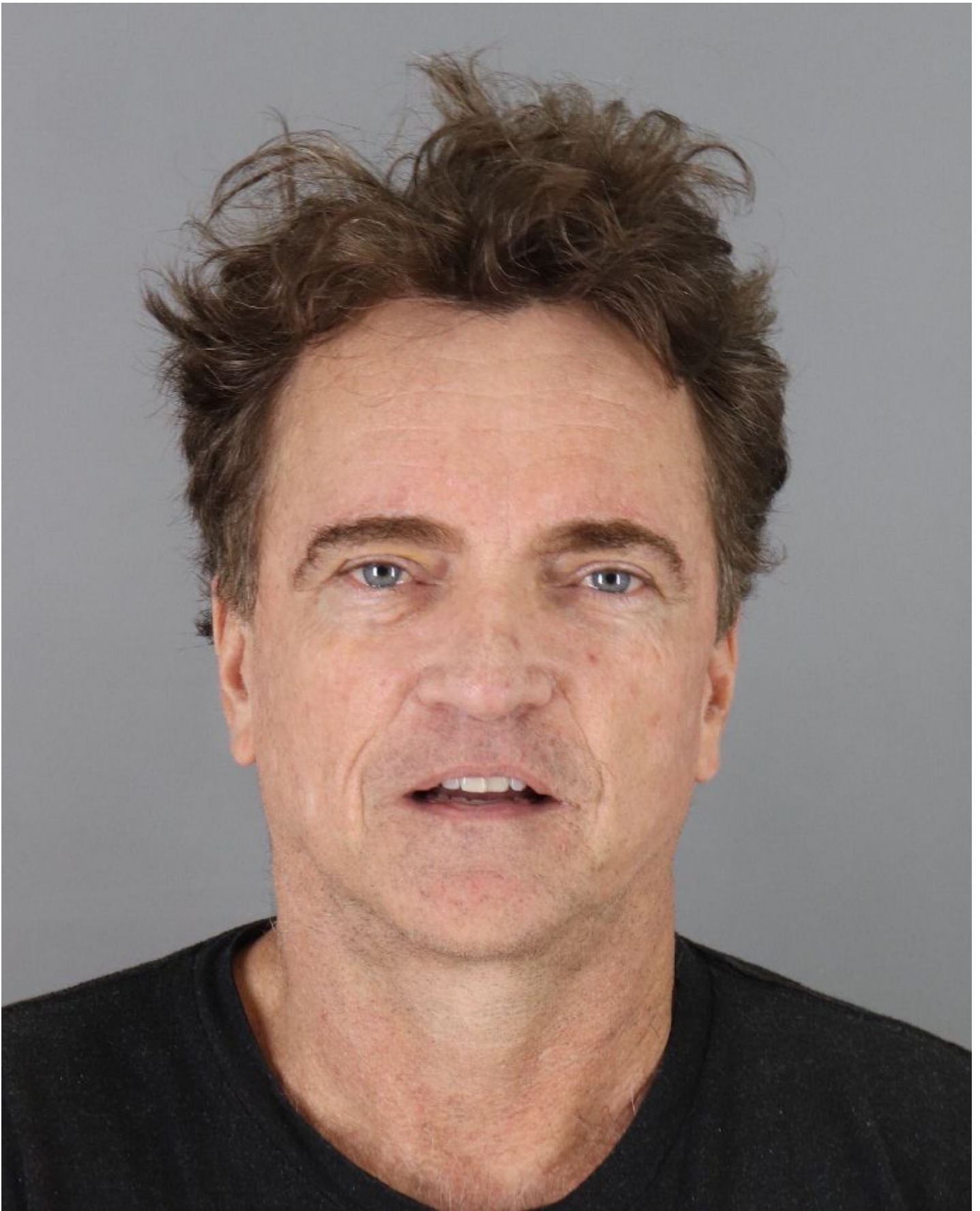
Through the investigation, multiple victims came forward about being sexually assaulted by Randolph "Randy" Haldeman who was a photographer for a swim team. At the time of these incidents, the male juvenile victims' ages ranged from 8-13 years old and some of the incidents took place at Haldeman's private residence in unincorporated Menlo Park as well.

On Thursday, July 25, 2019, Randolph Haldeman was arrested at his residence for lewd and lascivious acts with a child under 14 years old and booked into the San Mateo County jail.
