Incident Date and Time: Thursday, November 21, 2019, at approximately 11:10 am.

Location: Marshall's parking lot 2545 El Camino Real, Redwood City.

Type of Crime: PC12021.1(A) – Illegal possession of a firearm (felony)
PC 21310 – Carry dirk or dagger (felony)
H&S 11378 - Possession of a controlled substance for sale (felony)

Suspect: **Hector Gonzalez, 25-year-old, Moss Beach resident.**

Summary:

On Thursday, November 21, 2019, at approximately 11:10 am, a San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Deputy stopped a car for a traffic violation in the parking lot of the Marshalls store.

During the stop, the driver falsely identified himself, but was later confirmed to be 25-year-old, Hector Gonzalez from Moss Beach. A search of his identity confirmed he had two outstanding felony arrest warrants for drug related charges.

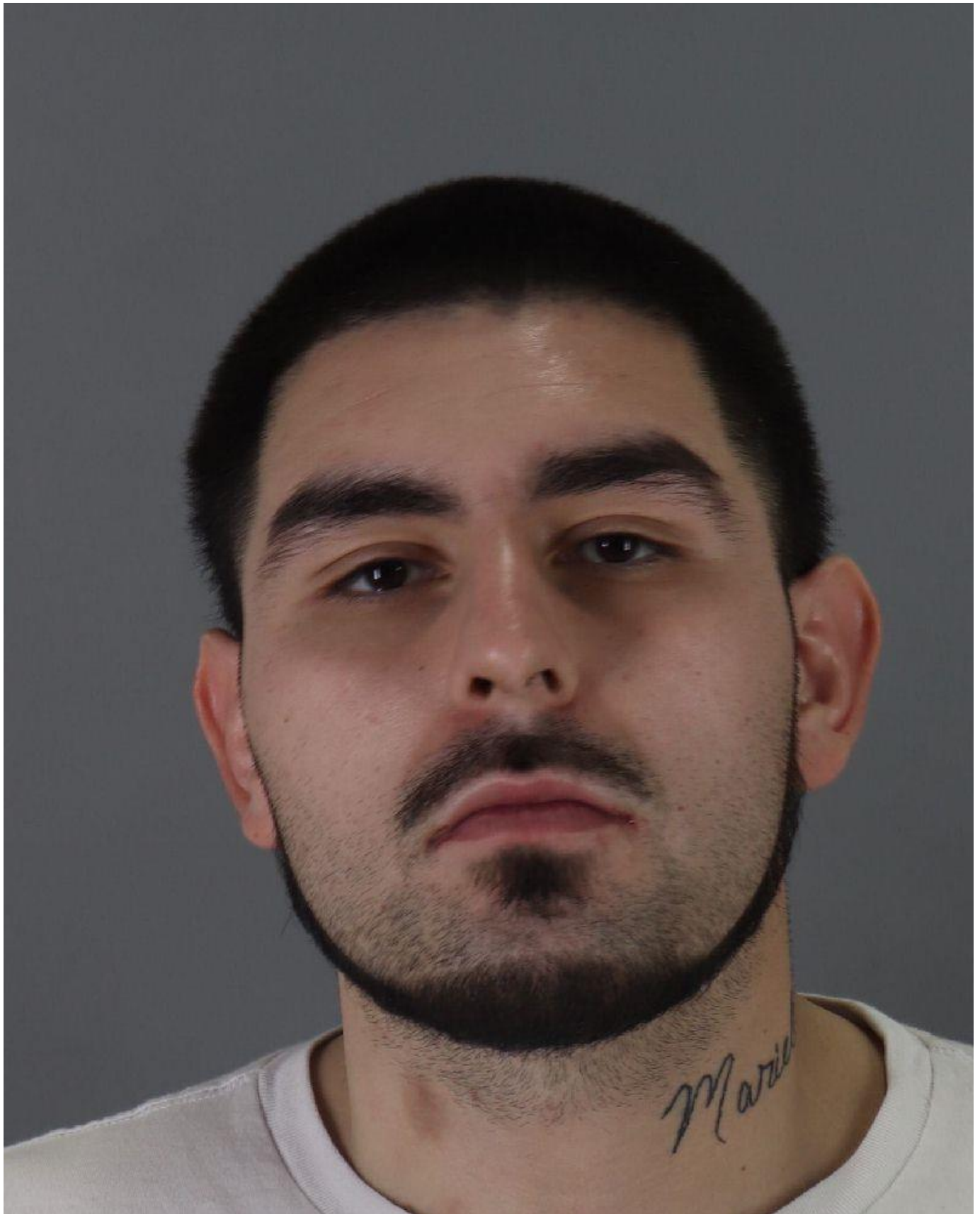
While searching the suspect's vehicle, deputies located a loaded firearm, a stun gun, a dagger, and illegal narcotics.

Gonzalez was placed under arrest and booked into the jail on the outstanding felony warrants. In addition, he was charged with several other felonies in relation to the weapons and narcotics.
