Super Bowl LVII is a Win-Win When You Plan Ahead: Score a Sober Ride Home

Summary:

San Mateo County, California - The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office is reminding football fans that there is no "DUI" in team. If you are heading out to a Super Bowl party and you plan on drinking, make sure you stick to the ["Go Safely" game plan](#) and choose a sober way to go.

During Super Bowl LVII weekend, the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office will have additional deputies on patrol looking for drivers suspected of being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

"We want football fans in our community to enjoy Super Bowl festivities, but we also want responsible drivers on our roads," Sheriff Christina Corpus said. "Before you grab an alcoholic drink, remember the risk is too great to drive as you could hurt yourself or others. Let's all be winners and be responsible; make sure your game plan includes scheduling a ride-share or designating a sober driver. Choosing a safer way to go is something we can all root for."

The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office reminds the public that alcohol is not the only substance that impairs. Marijuana, prescription medications, and over-the-counter drugs may also impair your ability to drive safely. Do your research and understand how certain drugs may affect you.
