Location: Half Moon Bay High School, 1 Lewis Foster Drive, HMB

Type of Crime/Incident: PC 314-Indecent Exposure
PC 647.6-Annoy/Molest a Child under 18

Summary: On 3/22/21, deputies responded to a report of an unknown suspect who had exposed himself to a 13-year-old girl while parked in his vehicle at Half Moon Bay High School. The following day, a sketch artist assisted the Sheriff's Office with a sketch of the suspect, who was described as a Hispanic male in his 20's or 30's with brown hair and an accent.

On 5/24/21, a similar incident occurred in Atherton, when a suspect matching the above description pulled up next to a female juvenile while she was riding her bike home from school and exposed himself. Both investigations pointed to a white, newer-model Honda or Toyota sedan as the suspect's vehicle.

The investigation led to the identification of the suspect as Jose Salazar-Camacho, a parolee out of Mountain View. During a subsequent visit with his parole agent, Salazar-Camacho was placed under arrest for the above incidents. On 7/30/21, Salazar-Camacho had a preliminary hearing where he pled guilty to indecent exposure and annoying/molesting a child under 18. His sentencing in these cases is pending.
