Sheriff's Deputies Apprehend Attempted Murder Suspect in Inter-Agency Collaboration

San Mateo County, CA: In a swift and coordinated effort, on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, at 04:35 AM, the South San Francisco Police Department issued a notification to all allied agencies regarding an active attempted murder investigation within their jurisdiction. Responding with urgency, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies assigned to Headquarters Patrol, armed with suspect and vehicle information, successfully developed leads on the potential whereabouts of the suspect in unincorporated Menlo Park, CA.

As the deputies saturated the identified area, their search led to the discovery of the suspect's vehicle in the 600 Block of Hurlingame Ave. Deputies immediately alerted the South San Francisco Police Department while deputies kept an eye on the vehicle. It was during this moment that a subject matching the suspect's description was observed entering the identified vehicle. In response to the severity of the crime, deputies took immediate action, resulting in the safe apprehension of the suspect, identified as Kenneth Hamilton.

Kenneth Hamilton was subsequently transferred into the care and custody of investigators from the South San Francisco Police Department for further processing and inquiry.

This successful operation exemplifies the exceptional collaboration between law enforcement agencies in San Mateo County, showcasing their commitment to ensuring the safety and security of our residents. We appreciate our ongoing partnership with the South San Francisco Police Department, which highlights the effectiveness of inter-agency cooperation in tackling serious criminal offenses.
