### Summary:

"Today, the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office broke ground on the new San Mateo County Sheriff's Office John Arrillaga Sr. Headquarters Center. The new headquarters will be a significant and lasting step forward for the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office. This project was made possible by a substantial donation from Mr. John Arrillaga Sr., sadly, Mr. Arrillaga recently passed away. To honor Mr. Arrillaga Sr., the building will be officially named after him for his kindness and generosity.

The project completely renovates the existing 42,000 square foot Old Maguire Facility by enclosing the fourth floor and constructing a fifth floor. This additional space will allow us to relocate Sheriff's employees currently working on the third floor of the Hall of Justice, Headquarters Patrol, and Maguire Administration into the new building. This increased square footage also allows for growth as we move forward."
