**Incident Date and Time:** Sunday, June 27, 2021 at 9:15pm  
**Location:** Poplar Beach parking lot, Half Moon Bay, Ca

**Type of Crime/Incident:** 1) VC 20001(a) – Hit and Run Injury (Felony)  
2) VC 20002(a)1 – Hit and Run property (Misd)

**Suspect:** **Hispanic male adult, 20 – 25 years old, medium build, short brown hair, wearing a blue sweatshirt, and blue jeans**

**Vehicle:** **Older model black sedan, fleeing eastbound on Poplar Ave. continuing northbound on Highway 1.**

**Summary:**

At 9:15pm, Deputies of the Half Moon Bay Patrol Bureau of the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to a vehicle vs. pedestrian collision in the Poplar Beach parking lot. A black older model sedan backed into the victim knocking him to the ground. The vehicle fled eastbound on Poplar Ave. and was involved in a second collision into a residence fence at the northeast corner of Highway 1 and Poplar Ave. The vehicle then fled from the secondary collision scene northbound on Highway 1.
