**Incident Date and Time:** July 2, 2021 9:00 am

**Location:** Private Residence in Portola Valley, CA

**Type of Crime/Incident:** **PC 487(a) – Grand Theft**  
**PC 496(a) – Possession of stolen property**

**Suspect:** **Connor Timmons – 23 year old male**

**Summary:** On July 2, 2021, San Mateo County Deputies responded to the victim's residence in Portola Valley and took a report of jewelry that was stolen from her home. The victim believed her jewelry was taken by an employee from a pest control company that services San Mateo County and Santa Clara County. The employee was in her residence earlier in the day providing pest control services throughout her house. The victim discovered a large amount of her jewelry missing shortly after the employee, Connor Timmons, finished his job and left for the day.

San Mateo County Sheriff's detectives conducted follow up on the case and learned that Timmons was on searchable probation. On July 13, 2021, detectives contacted Timmons at his residence in Menlo Park and conducted a probation search. The search yielded a large amount of jewelry from his bedroom, including the Portola Valley victim's stolen jewelry. Timmons could not give an answer to how he obtained the additional jewelry. He was placed under arrest for the above charges and booked at the San Mateo County Main Jail.

Detectives believe that Timmons may have used his occupation to go into unsuspecting victims' homes to steal jewelry.
