Three Suspects Arrested for Breaking into 48 Cars

MILLBRAE, CA.- On March 11, 2023, at approximately 10:27 AM, San Mateo County Sheriff Deputies received an alert through the Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) System advising a stolen Hyundai was near the intersection of Millbrae Avenue and US 101 going eastbound, in the City of Millbrae. Deputies immediately responded to the area and began searching for the stolen car. As they were driving through the Westin Hotel parking lot, deputies heard a car alarm going and also discovered a car that had its window smashed.

Throughout the morning, the Sheriff's Office continued receiving reports of additional cars (approximately 48) being burglarized throughout the City of Millbrae.

A short time later, a witness reported the red Hyundai crashed into a residence at Helen Drive and Tioga Drive. The witnesses saw three males running away from the vehicle, jumping fences, and saw them enter the Green Hills Country Club.

With assistance from the San Bruno Police Department, deputies surrounded the area and the three suspects were located and safely taken into custody.

"We take the safety and security of our community very seriously," said Sheriff Christina Corpus. "I am proud of the men and women who serve our communities, and I am grateful to the San Bruno Police Department for their assistance."

The three suspects arrested were identified as Amir Burke, 20 years old, from Oakland, Maurice Grace, 18 years old, from Oakland and the third suspect is a minor 13 years old, from Oakland, who was booked into San Mateo County Youth Services Center on the following charges:

PC 460(B), PC 496D(A) PC 148(A)(1), PC 182 and CVC 10851.



Suspects Burke and Grace were booked into the San Mateo County Jail on the following charges:

PC 460(B), PC 496D(A) PC 148(A)(1), PC 182, CVC 20002 and CVC 10851
