Summary:

On August 21, 2021, San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched the 1700 block of Lexington Avenue, in Unincorporated San Mateo County, on a report of two subjects acting suspiciously by looking into and under vehicles. Upon arrival Deputies contacted Laspisa and Bui. They were unfamiliar to the area and found to be in possession of burglary tools. Further investigation revealed that the subjects had broken into two vehicles, stole items from those vehicles and attempted to steal one of the vehicles for transportation purposes. Both subjects admitted to committing the crimes.

They were placed under arrest for the above listed charges and subsequently booked into the San Mateo County Jail without incident.
