Type of Crime/Incident: Mountain Lion Sighting

Summary:

On July 4th, 2021, at approximately 11:25 p.m., the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office received a report of a mountain lion sighting on Brittan Avenue in the City of San Carlos. The reporting party described the mountain lion as older, large, and non-aggressive. The mountain lion was last seen walking westbound towards the Pulgas Ridge Open Space Preserve.

If anyone sees a mountain lion in or near their neighborhood, use caution and please call the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office to report the sighting.
