Missing Person: Florentino Suan Pasco Jr. 36 Years Old-Transient

Summary:

On June 24, 2021, at approximately 5:00 AM, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Deputies from the Coastside Patrol Bureau responded to the area of Tunitas Creek Beach, in Unincorporated San Mateo County, on a report of a male subject who was in the water and distressed. Upon arrival, Deputies contacted the reporting parties who said that at approximately 4:00 AM, one of their friends wandered off while they were on the beach and did not return. The missing person was identified as Florentino Suan Pasco Jr., transient out of Stockton, California. The friends were unable to locate Florentino and believed he went into the water.

The Sheriff's Office and allied agencies, including the United States Coast Guard and San Mateo County Harbor Patrol, dispatched and deployed several search and rescue resources including the USCG helicopter, rescue vessel, and SMSO drone. All efforts to locate Florentino were exhausted and he was not located.
