Armed Subject passed away from self-inflicted gunshot wound

Unincorporated San Mateo County Coast – On Monday, February 27th, 2023, at approximately 1:05 PM, San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Coastside Patrol Deputies responded to report of shooting that had just occurred in the 400 block of El Granada Blvd., in El Granada. Upon arrival, Sheriff's Deputies located a 67-year-old El Granada resident with a self-inflicted gunshot wound, who was subsequently transported to the hospital, where he later passed away. During the course of the investigation, Sheriff's Deputies and Detectives learned the deceased man had been in a confrontation with his neighbors, and did fire his gun in their general direction, prior to taking his own life. Thankfully, no one else was injured during the earlier neighbor dispute. The suspected firearm involved was located at the residence and collected for evidence.

Sheriff's Detectives do not believe any further threat to the public exists as this appears to have been an isolated event.
