Suspects: **Arrested** – Samuel Kankel
27 year-old-male (Belmont Resident)

San Carlos, Ca – On Thursday, April 7, 2022 at approximately 1:14 a.m., San Mateo County Sheriff's Deputies assigned to the San Carlos Patrol Bureau responded to investigate a report of a stabbing which occurred on the 700 block of Elm Street in the City of San Carlos. During the investigation, Patrol Deputies learned a 32-year-old male victim had been stabbed sustaining serious injury. The victim was taken to a medical center due to the severity of his injuries. The subject remains hospitalized and in stable condition.

Patrol Deputies identified the suspect as **Samuel Kankel** of Belmont. Sheriff's Detectives responded to assist with the investigation which continued throughout the day.

At approximately 11:00 p.m., the investigation led Sheriff's Detectives to the 1600 block of Sunnyslope Avenue in the City of Belmont. Detectives along with Deputies assigned to Sheriff's Patrol, Sheriff's K-9 and the Sheriff's Unmanned Aerial Systems units ultimately contacted Samuel Kankel in a residence where he was taken into custody. Samuel Kankel was later booked into the Maguire Correctional Facility for a violation of Attempted Murder.
