Swearing in Undersheriff Chris Hsiung and Assistant Sheriff Ryan Monaghan

Redwood City –Today, at 3:00 PM, San Mateo County Sheriff Christina Corpus will swear in Undersheriff Chris Hsiung and Assistant Sheriff Ryan Monaghan at the Old Courthouse, located at 2200 Broadway, Redwood City.

"I'm excited to welcome Chief Hsiung to the team, and to bring him home to San Mateo County," said Sheriff Christina Corpus. "This is a renowned professional with a demonstrated commitment to enhancing community safety and officer wellness. We share a modern approach to this work, and I know he will help me make the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office a premier law enforcement agency."

Chief Hsiung will become the first Asian American Undersheriff in San Mateo County history. He is the son of immigrants and a first-generation San Mateo County native, growing up in Foster City and graduating from Hillsdale High School. He began his law enforcement career over 34 years ago with the Foster City Police Department, serving as a police explorer and Community Service Officer. Chris served as the Police Chief of the Mountain View Police Department, where he worked for the last 28 years.

Sheriff Christina Corpus will also swear in Ryan Monaghan, the former Chief of the Tiburon Police Department and a 26-year veteran of the San Mateo Police Department. Ryan Monaghan will join the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office as the Assistant Sheriff of Operations.



"Assistant Sheriff Monaghan is a police leader that will help us implement modern, proactive approaches to policing," said Sheriff Corpus. "His demonstrated operations and tactical expertise will enhance our efforts around major crimes, investigations, and bolster our response to domestic violence. I am grateful to have him join my team. This is a professional with deep roots in this community who has worked closely with the county's law enforcement agencies to enhance public safety."
